How to use WebOPAC in college library


The Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC) is used to find out what books/documents are available in our college. Follow the below steps

Step-1

Find the icon named WebOPAC”  on desktop in college library PC’s and click it.

Step-2

For GUEST Login: NO PASSWORD directly click Submit button

You can see the latest addition to the Library by choosing this option. This search goes through the entire database for the search hence it may take little more time than normal searches.


On clicking Submit, the query condition is passed through a search engine to yield the search result. The result of all the searches can be either refined or printed. The matching documents are displayed on the screen. You may view further details of the document by selecting a particular document. If the document is part of a Multi-part collection, the Collection name is displayed next to the Accession Number in italics. If there is a Multimedia file attached to this document you may view the same by clicking on the icon. Please make sure that the appropriate viewer or application is loaded before viewing the multimedia file.



Enter the string, you can search using any option like author, title or keywords that you have into the search box and accordingly select the criteria. Then Click submit button.




A list of relevant documents will appear. Click on the record and note down Accession Number or Call Number and Author's name.
