**Opportunities for improvements as suggested by the Members of the Expert Committee who visited the institution for assessment for accreditation are placed below :**

**Programme : Computer Engineering**

- Transparency is not satisfactory.
- Post Office, medical facility and Transport is not provided.
- Qualification of supporting staff is not satisfactory.
- Participation of Students in Competitive Examinations is poor.
- R&D activities and interaction with industry and other academic institutions are not satisfactory.

## Programme : Instrumentation Engineering

- Budget is inadequate to meet expenditure for new building / building up extra infrastructure facilities.
- Non recurring budget is not sufficient to meet expenditure of salary for staff and 1:15 ratio, especially to meet salary of staff at professor level.
- Non recurring budget is inadequate to meet expenditure on additional staff requirements as per AICTE norms.
- There is no provision to set up a departmental library.
- Due to constraints of space in Mumbai, Physical facilities are not expanded
- There is no bank / post office / hostels / medical facilities available in the campus.
- Even though promotional facilities are available many faculty do not avail the same due to family constraints.
- The cadre ratio is to be improved by inducting senior faculty.
- The teacher student ratio is to be improved as per norms.
- Library must be properly digitised with adequate training to staff.
- Few students take part in competitive examinations.
- Remedial classes are required for students.
- Student feed back system must be uniform and transparent.
- Library space is too low and the facilities are limited within course syllabi.
- NSS & NCC activities are to be implemented
- Entrepreneurship development must be activated.
- R&D / Consultancy must be started.
- Sponsored projects are not undertaken.
