I am directed to state that the All India Council for  
Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to the  
Viveknand Education Society's Institute of Technology, Bombay  
to conduct the following degree courses during 1992-93 with an  
intake shown against each:

The above approval is subject to the fulfilment of the  
following conditions:

- (1) The polytechnic which is being run by the same Management in  
the same complex as the Engineering Institute shall be  
separated completely from the Engineering Institute by May,  
1995 showing progress towards this each year to the  
satisfaction of the AICTE.
- (2) The Management will take necessary steps by September 15,  
1992 for getting the existing polytechnic approved by the  
AICTE.

- (3) The existing faculty strength of five Professors, six Asst. Professors and 42 Lecturers shall be improved by recruiting additional faculty as per the schedule given below:

- (3) Technical supporting staff shall be recruited for bringing their strength upto the AICTE norms in each year.
- (4) Adequate teaching laboratory and workshop area shall be provided each year to the satisfaction of the AICTE and substantially in accordance with the AICTE norms.
- (5) No new course shall be started in the Engineering Institute without the prior approval of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).
- (6) The intake in any year in any of the AICTE approved courses shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (7) The Management including the Governing Council of the Institute shall be constituted as per the AICTE guideline and also the Chairman shall be appointed as per the AICTE guidelines.
- (8) Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
- (9) The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- (10) The teaching staff shall be recruited on an All India basis by open selection, and as per procedure, qualifications, experience, etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selection would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based selection" as a general policy.

- (11) The accounts of the Institute shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
- (12) Two duly registered undertakings (general+specific one for removal of deficiencies) shall be submitted by October 15, 1992 in the format already sent to the Institute.
- (13) The Institute shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the Society or the Institute with the above conditions, the AICTE will be free to take measures for the closure of the programme and withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to closure would be that of the Society and/or the Institute.


An Expert Committee of the Western Regional Committee (WRC) will visit the Institute in April/May, 1992 to assess compliance with the above conditions. Further approval or otherwise of the Engineering degree programmes after the academic year 1992-93 will be considered by this Council based on the report of the Expert Committee as stated above.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action in the matter and keep the WRC, Bombay and this Office informed of the progress made in this behalf.
