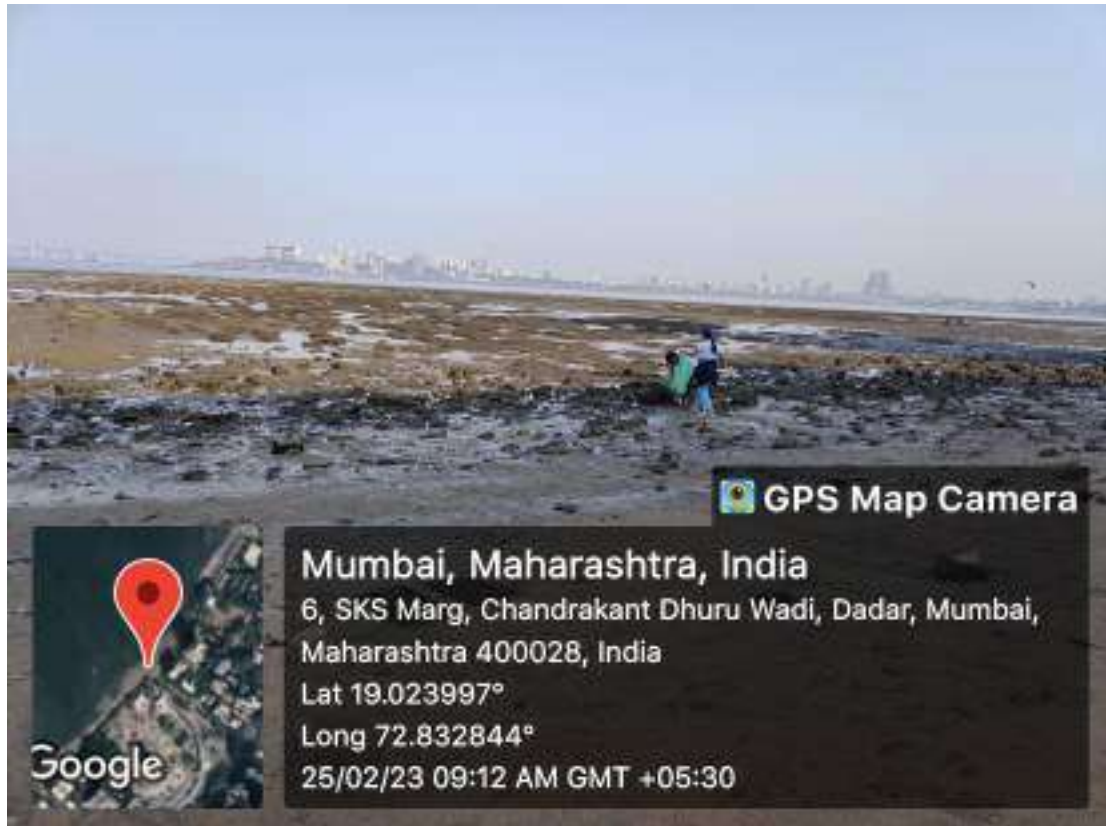
The students and faculties were called at chowpatty at 8:00 am sharp. The cleanup started at 8:30am and was conducted till 11:30 am.
