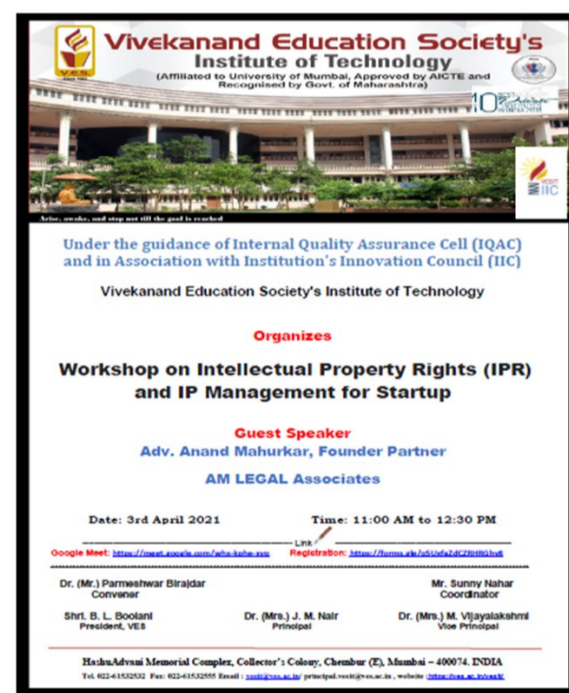


- ◆ A Quiz about “**Advanced Web Technologies**” was organized for MCA2A students on 28 April 2021 by Prof. Vaishali Gatty.

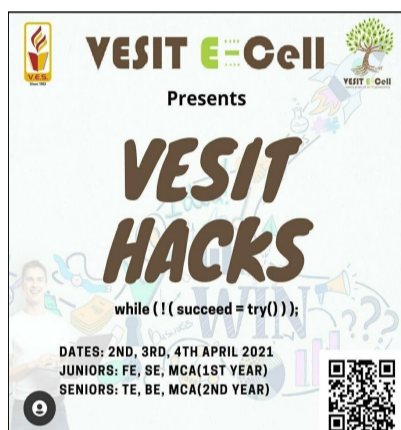

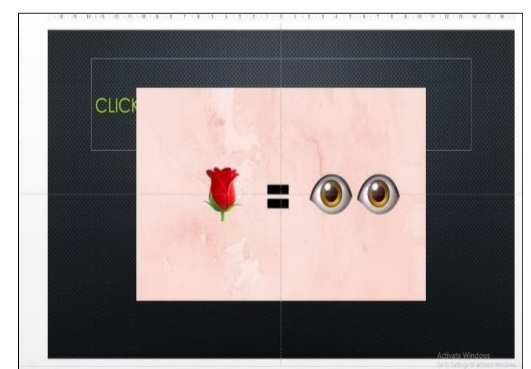
