- e. VESIT-IT shall not use the name & logo of any other company in the Swechchha Project without prior express written consent of SUD Life. Any breach of this term shall be considered as material breach of the terms and conditions of this MOU and such default shall be liable for cost and damages.
- f. VESIT-IT acknowledges that the trademark and trade name and all trademarks and trade names of SUD Life or SUD Life are the exclusive property of SUD Life or its affiliated companies; and VESIT-IT is not entitled, either by implication or otherwise, to any title in or use of the Trademarks, except in accordance with the express written permission of the authorised signatory of SUD Life, such permission to be given or withheld at the sole discretion of SUD Life.
- g. In case of any changes in the branding of SUD Life; SUD Life shall inform accordingly to VESIT-IT and VESIT-IT shall be under obligation to carry such changes of all the existing online and offline platforms or if under process of being developed, without any cost obligation on SUD Life.
- h. Notwithstanding anything contained in this MOU, during the subsistence of this MOU or on termination, SUD Life at its sole discretion may instruct in writing to VESIT-IT to temporarily or permanently discontinue usage of the branding of SUD Life and VESIT-IT shall be under obligation to immediately discontinue such usage, without any cost obligation on SUD Life.

**8. INDEMNITY**

- a. VESIT-IT further agrees to hold harmless and indemnify SUD Life and SUD Life and its employees from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, proceedings, judgments, liabilities, fees, expenses and disbursements relating to or arising out of (i) misuse of the Financial Support received from SUD Life or (ii) any breach of the covenants/ provisions contained in the MOU or (ii) infringement of any 3<sup>rd</sup> party IPR; or (iv) breach of applicable law; or (v) any act or omission of VESIT or its employees, agents etc., while implementation of the Swechchha Project.
- b. Notwithstanding anything contrary contained in this MOU, neither party shall not be liable for any special, indirect, consequential, or incidental damages (including but not limited to damages for loss of business profits, business interruption, loss of business information, and the like) arising out of this MOU, any documents referenced in this MOU, or any addenda or amendment hereto.  
This clause shall survive the expiry or the earlier termination of this MOU.

**9. Term & Termination**

- a. This MOU shall come into effect from the date of its execution and shall remain valid for a period of two (2) years or the date of completion of the Swechchha Project, whichever is later.
- b. Notwithstanding anything contained hereinabove, SUD Life may forthwith terminate this MOU, without notice and with immediate effect for any of the following reasons
  - i. In the event of any regulatory directive or deviation from the terms of this MOU, SUD Life can forthwith terminate this MOU.
  - ii. Gross negligence or fraud by VESIT-IT or any of its representative or employees, while implementation or operation of the Swechchha Project.
  - iii. Dissolution of Financial Support by VESIT-IT for any other purpose then the one specified in the MOU hereof.
  - iv. Breach of any terms and conditions of this MOU or VESIT-IT-MCGM MOU
- c. In case of termination, prior to full utilization of the Financial Support and/or completion of the Swechchha Project, any unutilized Financial Support shall be refunded by VESIT-IT to SUD Life without any demur or protest. VESIT-IT hereby undertake, to fully demonstrate by way of invoices, receipts or any other documents, to SUD Life of expenses already incurred/committed by it on the Swechchha Project till the time of termination.
- d. Notwithstanding anything contained in this MOU, it is agreed that the obligation of VESIT-IT as mentioned in clause 7 (Branding) shall continue even post expiry/ termination of the MOU.






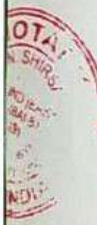
Both parties can terminate this MoU in writing to the other party with thirty days' notice.

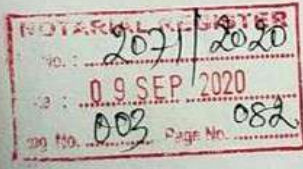

**Whereas:**

- 5.3. Each Party agrees that all confidential information shall be kept confidential and secret shall not be disclosed to any person except to the employees or advisors of such Party on a need to know basis in connection with the transactions contemplated by this MOU. Event if any information is so disclosed, the disclosing Party shall be responsible for any breach by such persons of any confidentiality obligations in respect of such disclosed information.
- 5.4. The foregoing obligations of confidentiality shall not apply to nor restrict the use of information which (a) was already in the possession of the recipient at the time of disclosure and of which the recipient has evidence of such possession; (b) was received from a third person having the right to disclose it; (c) is required to be disclosed as a result of a court order, provided the recipient gives the disclosing Party prior notice of such disclosure so that the disclosing Party may intervene in the proceedings to protect the confidential nature of the confidential information; (d) is required to be disclosed pursuant to any applicable law; or (e) is available publicly otherwise than due to a default of the recipient of such information.
- 5.5. No public announcement of the subject matter of this MOU shall be made by any of the Parties, except with the prior approval of the other Party unless such Party is required to make a disclosure under the provisions of applicable law. If required to be made, the text of the public announcement shall be mutually agreed between the Parties.

#### 6. Term, Termination and Survival

- 6.1. This MOU will be valid for a period of one and half years from the date of execution. Parties can anytime decide to extend on renew the MOU before its termination.
- 6.2. Parties can agree to terminate the MOU before due date by giving a notice of 2 months to each other.
- 6.3. It is expressly agreed that the confidentiality provisions specified in Clause 5 shall survive termination and be valid for a period of 2 (Two) years from the date of termination of this MOU.

#### 7. Representations and Warranties

The arbitrators shall be entitled to award interest, costs and expenses including reasonable attorney's fees.

10.1. This MOU is intended to be fully binding on the Parties in accordance with its terms.




- 4 Confidentiality: IITB and VESIT agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained/disclosed from either party or created during the performance of this agreement and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party.
- 5 Non-Exclusive: This relationship is on a non-exclusive basis and either VESIT or IITB are free to enter into other relationships or alliances with other partners.

## 14. E-copy of Automation Industry Association MoU:

### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is entered into, on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2015, between

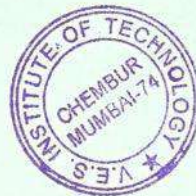
AUTOMATION INDUSTRY ASSOCIATION, a registered Society having its registered address c/o M/s HFK Madan & Company, 30, Oriental Insurance Building, 31, Dr. V. B. Gandhi Marg, Mumbai - 400001. (hereinafter referred to as "AIA" which expressions shall include its successors, administrators, and assigns)

AND

V.E.S. Institute of Technology, Hashu Advani Memorial Complex, Collector Colony, Chembur, Mumbai - 400074 (hereinafter referred to as "VESIT" which expressions shall include its successors, administrators, and assigns)

Both parties hereby commit to collaborate towards the establishment of a Teaching and Training Centre (ATTC) in the area of Integrated Industrial Automation, to meet the aforesaid objectives as in the preamble. The collaboration is intended to create a holistic and broad-based teaching and skill building facility, through a well-placed curriculum and environment that brings relevant and contemporary technologies and industrial practices to the academic institutions.

This MoU sets out the terms and conditions as detailed in the Annexure, to establish the initial framework and set of activities covering all the 3 pillars of existence, to the mutual satisfaction of both parties. The MoU provides for a longer term arrangement by its conversion to a Memorandum of Agreement after the pilot phase is declared complete and evaluated by both parties.



11. Intellectual Property Rights: No party shall assume ownership of the material developed and shared by the other party. Where curriculum inputs are jointly improved, such updates shall be publicly acknowledged and protected from piracy or misuse by third parties.

12. Promotion: VESIT and AIA can issue a joint Press Release (contents to be mutually agreed) to inform the public about this collaboration and joint events. VESIT and AIA are entitled to post, at their own discretion, the collaboration highlights herein and details of related activities on their respective websites. Branding of ATTC's will be distinct, while allowing the use of both party logos

13. All bi-lateral issues will be reviewed together on a semi-annual basis, by a joint Council comprising representatives of VESIT and AIA. In addition, VESIT will participate in an annual academic review with the community of peer ATTCs affiliated with AIA. Inputs from this larger body will be considered while preparing the blueprint for advanced courses.

14. Term: The duration of the MoU will be 2 years commencing from the effective date. Thereafter, VESIT and AIA shall review the status of the collaboration and may enter into a longer term Memorandum of Agreement on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed to by the parties in writing. In the event that either party wishes to terminate or extend the MoU period before the completion of the initial term, it may initiate the process by giving the other party a six month advance notice in writing.

15. Amendments to the MoU;

Changes and /or deviations are likely to appear both in context and extent of the subject matters covered under this MoU. VESIT and AIA accept this situation and agree to accommodate for this, as necessary, by mutual agreement and by exchange of further communication in writing, specifying these changes and /or deviations.

16. The relationship between the Parties is that of an independent party for this MoU and neither Party shall represent to third parties as an agent of the other Party. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to grant either Party the right to



make commitments of any kind for or on behalf of the other Party without the prior written consent of the other Party.

17. Neither Party shall assign or transfer its rights and obligations under this MoU without the prior written consent of the other Party.


18. Resolution of Disputes :


