BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY (CRITERION NO.):-

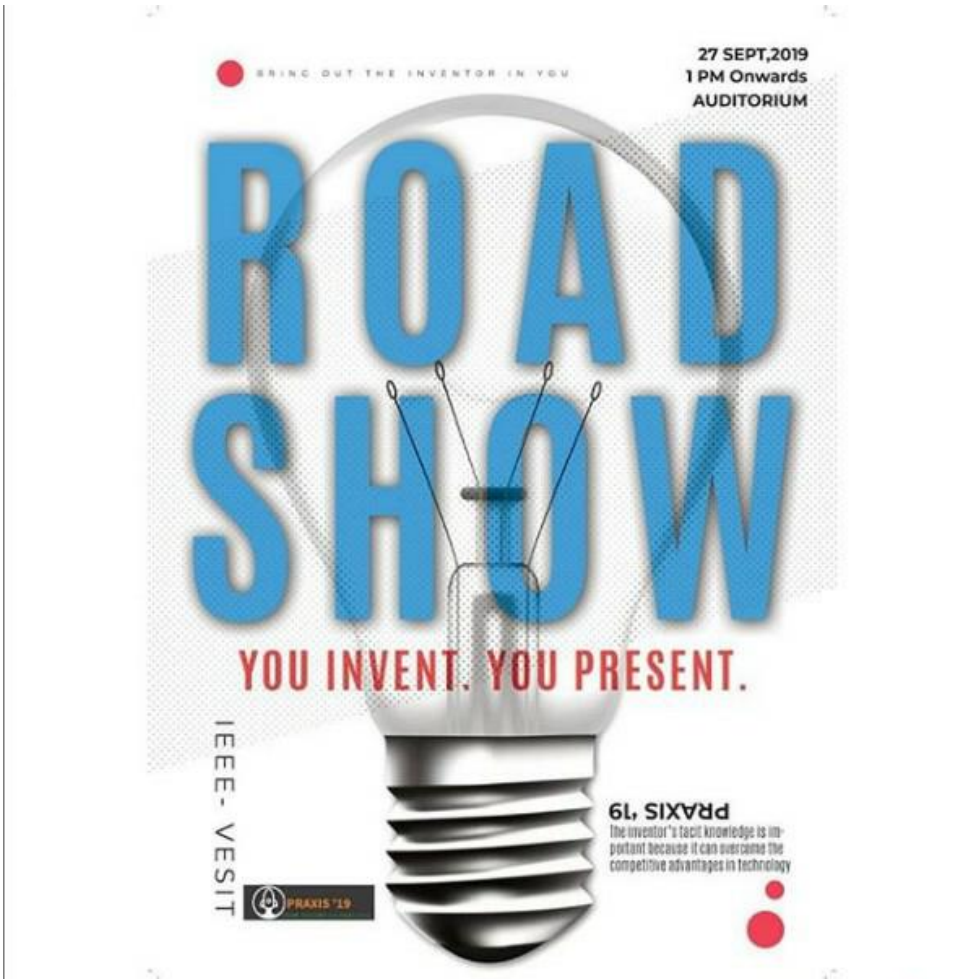
TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	IEEE-VESIT believes that in today's world the need of inventors has risen exponentially. Hence, IEEE-VESIT organizes the event ROADSHOW every year in order to encourage young minds create new things in order to tackle modern problems.
OBJECTIVES	The participants were allowed to make teams of up to 5 members and were given 7 domains to choose from, namely - agriculture, defense, energy conservation, health care, transportation, home and industrial automation, and smart city services. They were expected to come up with products or ideas which were aimed to solve any problem faced in any of the seven domains and pitch those products to the judges present.

METHODOLOGY	The competition was divided into two rounds. The preliminary round consisted of an abstract submission of the product they were going to pitch. This round was an online round where the participants were asked to e-mail their abstracts. The selected teams were then called for the on-campus presentation round. Here they were supposed to pitch their products in front of the two judges. All the teams were given a time limit of 7 minutes to pitch their idea. This was followed by a 3-minute question and answers session where the judges and even the audience were allowed to ask questions to the team. The teams were also asked to make a hardware or a software prototype of their project. The teams were then judged based on four criteria which included implementability, relevance to domain, quality of the prototype, and the quality of answers given to the questions asked.

BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY (CRITERION NO.):-

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Mastermind was an exciting and fast paced event. It was an individual game which evaluated one's general and technical knowledge in the form of a puzzles & questions.
OBJECTIVES	The challenging questions and the fun element of the game made this a popular event. It was a logical game which tests the aptitude of students and their ability to work with time constraints.
METHODOLOGY	The game consisted of 10x10 grid of tiles of which behind every tile for the Duration of 5 minutes, Participants were projected to various shapes of distinct colours viz 'red square', 'yellow donut' etc. along with '+' and '-' points. A time period of 10 minutes were given to figure out the respective pair of colour & shape on the basis of which a question was provided. If the participants answered the question correctly they were awarded 10 points else 5 points were deducted from their score. The winner was decided on the basis of maximum no. of points attained in the given time constraint of 15 minutes.

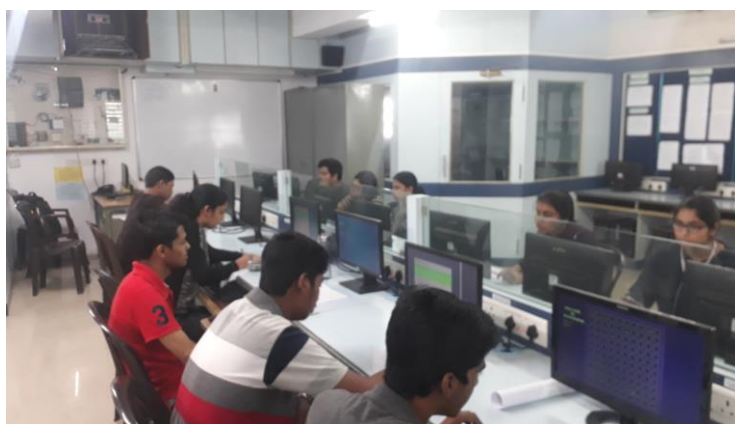

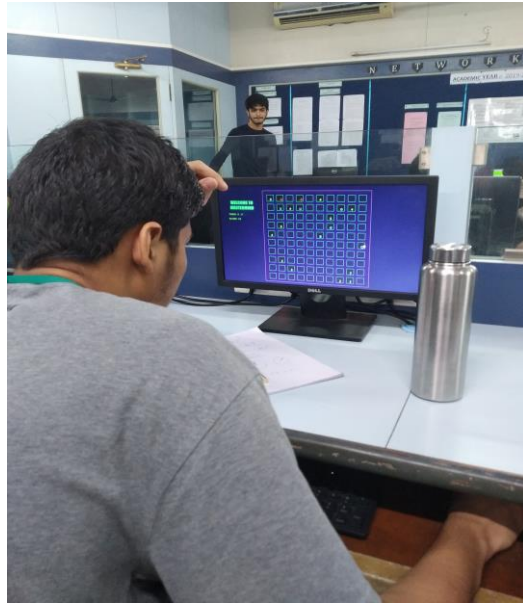

BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY (CRITERION NO.):-

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Film-It Workshop was essentially organised to provide a platform for participants to test their creativity and liking in the grounds of Film-making.
OBJECTIVES	The main objective of this event was that participants were taught that every big project or movie or even an ingeniously formulated snippet has hours of brainstorming and patience involved, and that content creation is not as laid back as the editors make it.
METHODOLOGY	Our Senior Editor Suraj Bathija started off with some examples of how videos work and how FPS is a significant factor to always be aware of, with regards to editing. A wide range of examples was also demonstrated by him in the editing scenario. He taught the participants the fundamentals of editing on Adobe Premiere PRO, and simultaneously explained the reason and the result of each step and function within Premiere Pro. Various types of cuts used in editing, like the Jump cut, L cut, Standard cut, Cross Dissolve, Wipe etc. were thoroughly explained and demonstrated how each one provides a different aspect to the overall video. Next on the list was audio. It is evident that audio carries a significant part when it comes to film making and being able to match the audio to the vibe of the video is a must. This was taught as Suraj went into the basics of audio mixing, and how if done at the right moment, audio helps to exponentially improve the emotions as display.
OUTCOMES	The attendees left the workshop with a newfound respect for movie editors.

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	The Android workshop using Android Studio marked the beginning of the chain of technical and exciting workshops exclusively conducted for the members.

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Self Defence is a countermeasure that involves defending the health and well being of oneself from harm. A workshop on self defence was conducted by IEEE-VESIT'S Women in Engineering. Skilled martial-arts and combat instructor and a gold medallist in All India Amateur MMA championship ,Mohit Dogra offered his advice and shared some of the key significant skills.

The most important aspect of the workshop was that the participants

	were not only supposed to watch but were made to practise those techniques. Special attention was given to each and every participant and it was made sure that they perfected the moves.

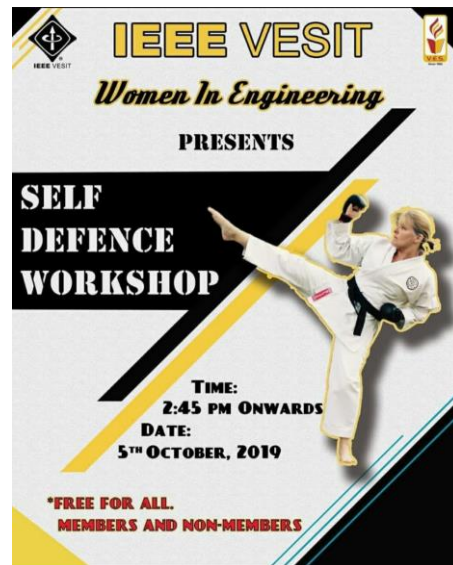

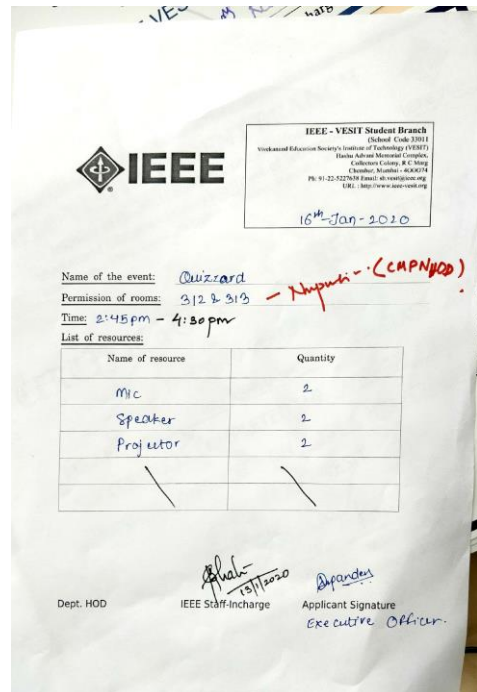
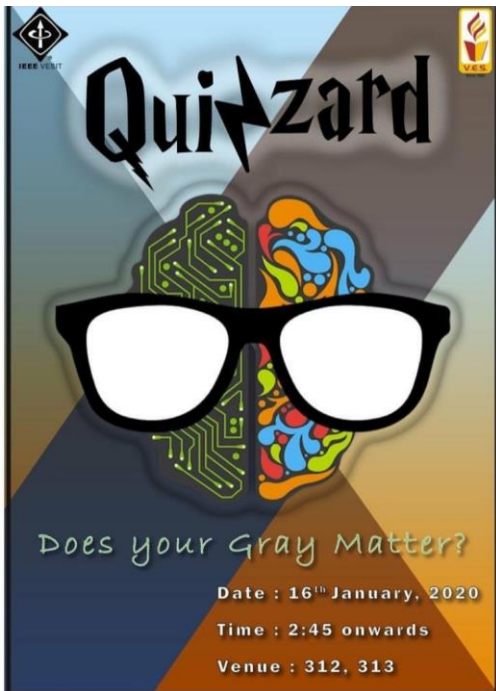

The non-participating teams were also allowed to answer for personality, albeit without revealing it to the other teams,</p> <p>which gave them 5 points for a correct guess and -5 for an incorrect</p>
	<p>one.</p> <p>Level 3: Spin the wheel</p> <p>In this round, the wheel was spun twice and the combination of two numbers pointed to a certain question. The participating team was given 30 seconds to answer the question. If answered correctly, 30 points were awarded but if answered incorrectly 10 points were deducted. If the Team chose to pass, the buzzer round was open and the first two teams to buzz, got 5 seconds each to answer the question.
